

Challenges:

The biggest challenge Excelsior face around sustainability is safe and sustainable disposal of waste. They currently convert a lot of wood waste to fuel using a BIOMASS boiler but still have high levels of general waste (waste that cannot be burned in the BIOMASS boiler).



At present they are researching waste disposal alternatives with a target to recycle or re-use a greater proportion of the waste produced.

Impact:

Since attending their first supplier day in 2016, Excelsior have continued to engage with the School through completing company and individual assessments, attending training and accessing resources:

- **Upskilling internal colleagues:** Through accessing resources, including e-learning modules, the team at Excelsior have upskilled themselves on various sustainability topics, including waste. The search function on the resource library helps them to easily access the resources that are useful to their business and job roles.
- **Benchmarking knowledge:** Excelsior have completed several assessments both as individuals and a company. The process was straight forward, and the dedicated action plans created as a result helped them understand where to focus their learning.

Value gained:

Excelsior Panelling Systems have gained value from being a Supply Chain Sustainability School member through:

- **Increased competitive advantage:** Engagement with the School shows clients, who recognise the School, that Excelsior are committed to learning about how to operate in a sustainable matter, which improves their competitive advantage.
