

FOCUS 2025 To consolidate learning on essential subject matter for all levels of worker in the construction sector

Create a scope-busting template

- Design a scope busting template that organisations can adapt and fill out with real-life, clear examples from within their own organisation and supply chain
- An accessible and direct tool to allow members and Partners to bring their supply chains and internal teams up to a base level of understanding of what scopes mean to them, with mapping to School resources
