Supply Chain Sustainability School Suggested Questions to Include in PQQs / ITTs



We recognise that it is important for our Partners to understand whether companies tendering for work are members of the School and their activity level. Below, we recommend some information which you could request to understand a potential suppliers' engagement with the School, and we remind you what information a supplier would not be able to provide.

What Sort of Information Can I Ask for in PQQs / ITTs?

- Is your company a member of the Supply Chain Sustainability School?
- What is your company's level of membership with the Supply Chain Sustainability School?
- Please attach your company's membership badge with the Supply Chain Sustainability School
- Do you have a valid corporate self-assessment with the Supply Chain Sustainability School?
- When did you last complete a corporate self-assessment with the Supply Chain Sustainability School?
- Please provide details of learning pathways completed on the Supply Chain Sustainability School
- Please provide an overview of your engagement with the Supply Chain Sustainability School
- Please provide examples of how you have used the resources / training available through the Supply Chain Sustainability School
- Please provide confirmation of the CPD time accrued by your company with the Supply Chain Sustainability School

Please note: Not all members of the School will appear in the membership directory as this is an optional field for them when they register, however you can either track suppliers directly through your Partner dashboard (*get in touch with the School team for more information or look at this video*) or ask members for proof through inclusion of their School membership level badge or dashboard screenshot.

What Information will Companies Not Be Able to Provide?

- Membership number (we do not give these out to our members)
- Self-assessment score
- Any data which contravenes GDPR (*e.g. contact details*)
