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Welcome to the Supply Chain Sustainability School



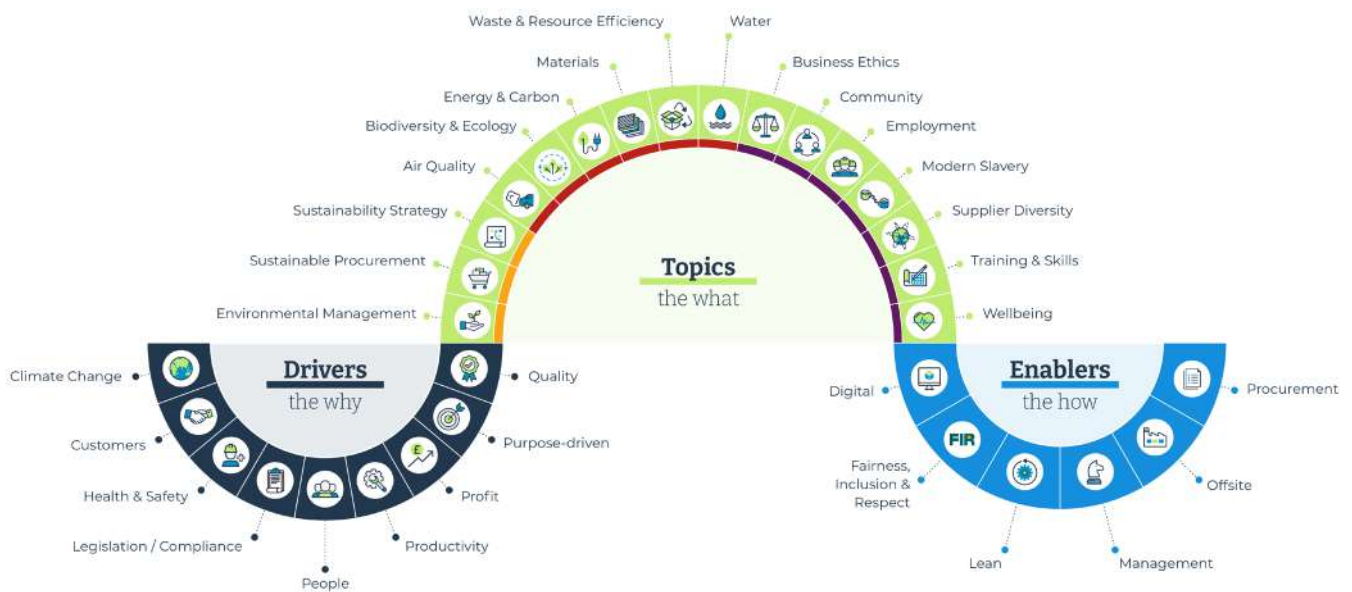
Established in 2012, the School is an industry-wide collaboration offering that develops and delivers training and support to help businesses adopt sustainable practices.
