


An Introduction to Learning Pathways

Our learning pathways feature allows you to allocate specific resources (and upload your own private content) into a curated learning journey which can be made available to your internal colleagues, students, employers or supply chain. You are able to track progress through the awarding of badges and downloadable reports.

For context, this is what a learning pathway looks like once you have enrolled on it. To view the contents of the learning pathway, you just need to click the **"VIEW PATHWAY"** button. The resources will then drop down as shown below. Once a resource has been completed, the box next to each resource will be filled with a green tick as highlighted in the red circle below.

This self-enrol learning pathway contains quick beginner-level resources, encompassing all the main sustainability issues and topics covered within the Supply Chain School, including waste, water, wellbeing, air quality, modern slavery, FM and FIR (Fairness, Inclusion and Respect) and more.
