

Case Study: Kendley Ltd

Challenges:

Sustainable Steel – Kendley Ltd faces challenges in finding, sourcing, and procuring steel from more sustainable production methods on behalf of its clients who aim to meet CO2 reduction targets on building projects. It is difficult to balance cost against environmental savings for its clients

Carbon Reduction – The company encounters challenges in capturing, understanding, and reporting on CO2 reductions for its organisation and projects undertaken for its clients. Establishing organisational and project carbon footprints involves working collaboratively with the supply chain, clients, and suppliers to determine baselines

Fleet – Kendley Ltd also faces challenges in transitioning its fleet and plant equipment to more sustainable alternatives while maintaining practical functionality both on-site and on the road

Impact:
