WS has developed a 'Fleet Replacement Programme' (FRP) aimed at ensuring the most efficient units operate across the entire fleet. The FRP and other initiatives demonstrate the progress being made. Additionally, the company is focusing on various areas, including lighting options and replacements in its buildings, waste reduction and recycling, alternative power, and collaborations to enhance transport solutions.

WS Transportation has successfully reduced its CO2 emissions from 1.44 kg per mile in 2021 to 1.15 kg per mile in 2024. The company is proud of this achievement and remains committed to ongoing investigations and improvements across the business.
