

Case Study: ACS Stainless Steel Fixings Ltd

Challenges:

As a manufacturer of stainless-steel structural building components, ACS Stainless Steel Fixings Ltd faces several challenges relating to sustainability within its operations.

One key issue is energy consumption. The significant investment in automation has led to increased energy demands. To address this, the company has implemented on-site renewable energy solutions, including over 1,000 solar panels that now generate approximately one-third of its total energy needs. The company is researching further investments in renewable energy to continue reducing its carbon footprint.

Packaging and distribution also present challenges, particularly due to the need to ensure the safety and stability of its products during transit. Currently, ACS Stainless Steel Fixings Ltd relies on polythene shrink wrap but is actively exploring alternative solutions to eliminate single-use plastics and begin to close the loop.
